A. Academic Achievement	Final Cumulative GPA 3.0 5 points	
	One additional point for each 10 th of a point over 3.0 (up to 15 additional points)	
B. Attendance	94% attendance rate for senior year 5 points	
	One additional point for each percentage point over 94% (up to 6 additional points)	
C. Citizenship	Student record absent of out-of-school and in-school suspensions 5 points	
D. Community Service	Minimum of 40 hours of service learning or volunteering 10 points	
	One additional point for each hour of service learning or volunteering over 40 hours (up to 10 additional hours)	
E. Activities	One point for each activity participated in during senior year (points will vary)	
	One additional point for holding leadership position in activity (points will vary)

Guidelines:

- Student must have a G.P.A. of 3.0 or above by the end of 1st Semester.
- Students must earn a minimum of 30 points to qualify as a Graduate of Distinction.
- Student must earn points from each of the five (5) categories.
- Community service and activity participation must be on approved list.
- Extra-curricular and co-curricular activities must have the sponsor's signature.
- Citizenship is calculated from August 9, 2017 through December 21, 2017. If a student commits a level 3, level 4, or level 5 offense after December 21, 2017, the student will not be eligible for the Graduate of Distinction Recognition.
