- 1. The Heisman High School Scholarship program recognizes and rewards male and female high school seniors who accomplish tremendous feats in the classroom, on the field, and most importantly, within their communities. Winning a Heisman High School Scholarship requires a weighted GPA of 3.0 or better, participation in at least one sport, and demonstrated leadership at school and in the community. Click Here to apply. The Deadline is October 17, 2023 by 3pm.
- 2. **The Coca-Cola Scholars Program scholarship** is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to students in their final year of high school. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, as well as their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities. <u>Apply here</u> through **October 2, 2023**.
- 3. The Cooke College Scholarship Program is an undergraduate scholarship program available to high achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend and graduate from the Nation's top 4-year colleges and universities. The Cooke College Scholarship Program application will open Thursday, August 24, 2023 through November 16, 2023. Click here to access the application. Scholarship recipients are announced. All semi finalists will be notified of their status via email by March 2023.
- 4. **AES Engineering Scholarship**. This award is available to high school seniors and all students attending a postsecondary educational facility. You are not required to be taking Engineering courses to be eligible. Students must submit an essay of between 500 and 1000 words and answer the following question: "When you look back on your life in 30 years, what would it take for you to consider your life successful? What relationships or accomplishments will be important on this journey?" Visit, **Scholarships** for an application.

- 5. UNCF Scholarships UNCF is the nation's largest private scholarship provider to minority group members. Each year more than \$100 million in scholarships is awarded to more than 10,000 students at more than 1,100 schools across the country.
