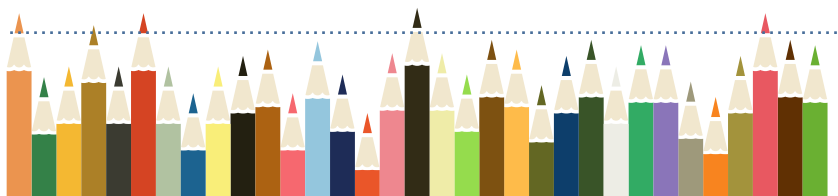
STUDENT ATTENDANCE
